- The impact of pupil premium strategy is recorded for 2016-17 and you have updated it for 2017-18 and that both are on the website.
- The impact of sports funding is recorded for 2016-17 and you have updated your action plan for 2017-18 and both are on the website.
- Ensuring your school's data for 2016-17 (summer) is on the website.
