

# School Asset Support Team (SAST)


The role of the School Asset Support Team is focused upon serving Children's Services and particularly overseeing the improvement and maintenance of the schools estate through delivery of the Children's Services Capital Programme.

The team is located within the Resources Directorate, working corporately to ensure that all schools premises are fit for purpose and actively support school improvement.



# SAST and Carbon Management

SAST are working to support the Council's priorities and will focus on Carbon Management within schools in order to achieve a targeted reduction in carbon emissions by 2021.



With this in mind, as the dynamics of the school estate alter in terms of the varying Responsible Bodies, including the Council, Diocesan Authorities and Academies (or their Trusts), it is important to tailor approaches around engagement with key colleagues and stakeholders effectively.

Our intention is to adopt the following proposals:

- Include Carbon Management into the Schools' Asset Management Plan 2018.
- Develop targeted Carbon Management Plans within school's individual updated Asset Management Plans.
- Support and promote involvement of the Ashden Workshops and any future programmes.
- Communicate carbon management updates to the entire school estate via termly SAST Bulletins.
- Investigate potential strategic carbon reduction schemes across the estate and possible funding streams to support this.
- Work towards the targets outlined in the Emissions Reductions Pledge 2020.
