## **Effective Classroom Observation**

Solihull LA has organised classroom observation training in association with Cambridge Education.

The training will be at Sans Souci Training Centre and involves 3 tutor-led days combined with 2 distance learning units and an assessed lesson observation. Training dates are **28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> January 2019** with the assessment day on **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April**. The intended audience is school senior leads, Solihull School Strategic Advisory Board peer reviewers and LA advisers. You will receive an Effective Classroom Observation training pack with supporting materials for use during the course and subsequently back at school – all aligned to the most recent Ofsted handbook. You will also be awarded a certificate on successful completion of your assessed task on day 3. Solihull School Strategic Advisory Board has contributed to reduce the cost of the training to attendees [usually £850 plus VAT] to encourage peer reviewers at the subsidised cost. The costs cover training, venue and refreshments.
