Holocaust Memorial Day - Monday 27th January 2020

Over many years, the Council and its partners have commemorated Holocaust Memorial Day by holding a service in Solihull. The service has developed year on year. The aim is for this Memorial Day to continue in 2020, involving Solihull's schools and colleges.

Holocaust Memorial Day (HMD) 2020 marks 75 years since the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau. The theme for HMD 2020 is *Stand Together*.

Schools and academies in Solihull are invited to:

- Send two three student representatives to the main service which will be held on Monday, 27th January 2020 (11.00-11.45), in the Council Chamber at the Civic Suite, Solihull. Students should be accompanied by one member of staff.
- Send a maximum of 10 pupils (this may change depending upon numbers interested) to a talk by Rabbi Pink about his own family's experiences during the Holocaust. This will take place in the refreshment room at the Civic Suite, Solihull between 1:00 pm -2:00pm - Year 6/KS 3, 4 or 5.
