Thank you for your continued support of the Holocaust Educational Trust.

I am writing to remind you that students from the schools and colleges in your network are eligible to take part on our upcoming *Lessons from Auschwitz* (LFA) Project. Our spring programme of visits will be taking place from the <u>West Midlands South</u>, <u>London South</u>, <u>Wales</u>, <u>East Midlands</u>, <u>West Midlands North</u>, <u>Eastern</u>, <u>South West</u>, and <u>Thames Valley & Chilterns</u> regions.

The LFA Project is open to two post-16 students and comprises of two seminars and a one day visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau, following which students are tasked with completing a Next Steps project and sharing their experience with their peers and local communities.

The cost to participate is only £59 per person and travel subsidies are available to help with travel and accommodation costs for the seminars and visit to Poland.

2020 will mark 75 years since the end of the Holocaust and the Second World War; we hope you will be able to join us in marking this significant anniversary year by having your students join us on our LFA Projects.
