Creating a cleaner, safer and more pleasant environment outside schools

**School Streets** – Prohibits vehicles moving into, out of or around the areas outside school during restricted times.

If you feel your school would benefit from this scheme, please register your interest.

**On The Move – Transition lessons –** Raises children's awareness of the importance of travelling sustainably and safely to their new secondary school.

- Year 6 delivered in the summer term prior to the children leaving their primary school.
- Year 7 delivered during the first term at secondary school.

## **Diffusion Tube Monitoring and Supporting Lessons/Assemblies**

 Schools sign up to a 12 month long diffusion tube monitoring the air quality in their school playground with supporting initiatives to educate the whole school.







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## 'Engines Off – Young Lungs at work' anti-idling of car engines outside the school.

- A banner for the railings and lamppost posters available for schools to borrow for a half term.
- A class/year group to write persuasive letters to parents that could be displayed around the school, sent as part of newsletter and posted on web page.
- An information leaflet advising parents of the dangers of leaving their engines idling.

## **ModeShift STARS**

- A free resource providing schools with the opportunity to create a School Travel Plan.
- Enables schools to work with the whole school community to promote cleaner, greener travel to school.
- Strongly recommended for all schools but a requirement for planning permission.
