




Foundation sustainability knowledge

- This is useful!!!
- The term 'sustainable development' (SD) can be defined as 'development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs' (United Nations, 1987).
- SD balances three interlocking priorities, attempting to consider economic, social and environmental concerns simultaneously – <u>all</u> <u>about systems thinking.</u>


