Drink Cartons

- Any fibre pack that is emptied. For example - milk carton, juice carton, etc.

- Solution or residue still in packaging

Coat Hangers

- All plastic hangers with or without metal hook.

- Wooden hangers and other materials.
- Hangers with cloth cover

Crisp Packets & Sweet Wrappers

- Empty crisp packets and sweet wrappers
- Biscuit wrappers and snack packaging

- Food content and liquid waste
- Hard rigid plastics and biodegradable plastics
- Foil-lined crisp tubes
- Hazardous waste (sharp, flammable, reactive, corrosive, ignitable, toxic, infectious or pathogenic).

Clothing & Textiles

- Casual wear (i.e. jeans, shorts, skirts, dresses, shirts, jerseys, hoodies, sweaters, cardigans)
 - Formal wear (i.e. tailored clothing, suits, ties, uniforms, blouses, blazers)
 - Outerwear (i.e. coats, denim jackets, windbreakers, gloves, scarves)
 - Activewear (i.e. sports bras, leggings, gym shorts, t-shirts, tops, headbands, swimsuits, wetsuits)
 - Lingerie and nightwear (i.e. undergarments, socks, tights, pyjamas, nightgowns, bathrobes)
 - Household textiles (i.e. bed sheets, linens, curtains, towels, aprons, tea towels, table cloths, dishcloths)
 - Leather and suede items
- Branded Uniforms
 - Accessories (e.g. belts, jewellery, eyewear)
 - Stuffed items (e.g. soft toys, pillows, duvets, blankets, stuffed coats)
 - Hazardous waste (sharp, flammable, reactive, corrosive, ignitable, toxic, infectious or pathogenic) which presents a danger to the environment, or to people
 - Batteries, pressurised canisters, broken glass and medical waste

Medical Packaging

Accepted items – Please ensure all packaging is empty & no-longer contains medicine, pills, liquid or sharps. Only plastic packaging is acceptable:

- Plastic Pill bottles like Vitamin bottles
- Plastic vials
- Plastic syringes (no sharps included, emptied of liquid & washed out)
- Plastic needle cap (ensure no needle inside)
- Plastic tubes (not from surgery and without bodily fluid)
- Drug tray
- Pipette boxes

- Food & liquid waste (or items coated with)
- Electronic waste (phones, laptops, batteries, etc.)
- Clothing & fabric items
- Hazardous waste (sharps, flammables, reactive materials, corrosives, ignitable, toxic) anything presenting a danger to people or the environment
- Pressurised canisters or aerosols
- Glass
- Surgical waste

Healthcare & Beauty Packaging

Only plastic packaging is acceptable:

- Hair care products: Shampoo bottles and caps, conditioner bottles and caps, hair gel tubes and caps, non-pressurized hair spray bottles, hair mask plastic jars and caps
- Facial skincare: Lip balm tubes, face soap dispensers and tubes, lotion bottles, lotion tubes, lotion dispensers and jars, non-pressurized shaving foam tubes, lip gloss tubes
- Makeup packaging: Mascara tubes, eye liner cases, eye shadow tubes, concealer tubes and lipsticks.

- Any content inside the package
- Glass such as eye shadow box, foundation bottle, nail polish, fragrance bottles, cream jars with glass body.
- Sharps objects such as razors
- Electronic items such as hair dryer, trimmer, straightener, batteries, etc.
- Metals such as bottle caps
- PAckaging made with bamboo
- Sheet masks for face, hands and feet
