# School training offer:



- **Get Pedalling - Balance & Learn to Ride – Y1**

Develops crucial early cycle handling and awareness skills using games on balance bikes, moves on to supporting children to master pedalling.

- **Bikeability Level 1 & 2 – Y5/6**

**Level 1** develops cycle handling in the playground and prepares riders for on road.

**Level 2** develops riders' skills and confidence for cycling on single-lane roads and navigating simple junctions in moderate traffic flows.

- **Bikeability Level 3 – Y6/7/8**

Develops riders' skills and confidence so they can commute to secondary school in diverse road environments, including busy roads and complex junctions

- **Bikeability Fix**

Teaches minor adjustments to support safe cycling

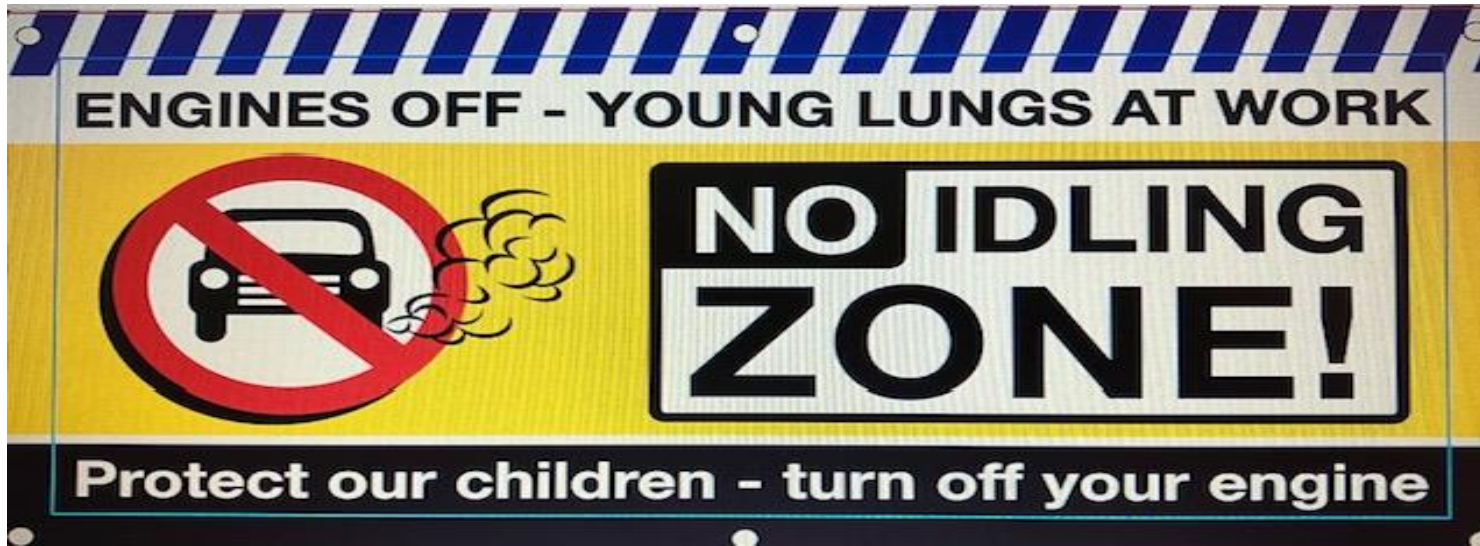

- Electric power with a 40 – 50 mile range
- Cheap and easy to charge
- No special requirements – just like riding a push bike
- Low cost, low carbon solution for the school run, commuting or moving goods around / between sites
- Make a significant contribution to air quality and reducing congestion
- SMBC can loan bikes or deliver roadshows on site
