Procedure for Managing Covid-19 Cases in Educational Settings in Solihull



If there are CONFIRMED Covid-19 cases a school/setting contact a Covid-19 advisor for guidance.

Approach to Managing the Cases

The Covid-19 Adviser would decide collaboratively with the school who has had close contact with a confirmed case whilst they were in the infectious period.

Definition of a Close Contact:

- a person who has had face-to-face contact (within one metre), with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, including:
 - o being coughed on
 - o having a face-to-face conversation within one metre
 - o having skin-to-skin physical contact, or
 - contact within one metre for one minute or longer without face-toface contact
- a person who has been within 2 metres of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes
- a person who has travelled in a small vehicle, like a car, with someone who has tested positive

Full Infectious period: from 48 hours prior to symptom onset (or the date of the test if asymptomatic) to 10 days after

Please note: Each case is managed individually and isolation numbers depend on individual circumstances and ages of the bubbles affected, for example for Early Years and up to Year 2, it is likely that a whole class/bubble and staff would need to isolate if there is a confirmed case. This may not be the case for older year groups.

Cases are managed as per national guidance (link)

Confirmed Covid-19 case numbers are monitored closely and schools/setting advised accordingly
