WHAT WILL I STUDY?

You will study the knowledge, skills and behaviours as set out within the apprenticeship standard, which will include the following subjects...

- Equality, diversity, and inclusion
- Safeguarding policies and procedures
- Health and safety
- Statutory and non-statutory frameworks
- The role and responsibilities of the key person
- Children's learning and development
- Enabling environments
- Observation, assessment, and planning
- Reflective practice

HOW WILL THIS COURSE BE DELIVERED?

The apprenticeship programme consists of 'on-the-job' and 'off-the-job' training. You will receive on-the-job training from your employer and will also be allowed 20% offthe job training, which will involve your college day-release and independent study. Apprenticeship duration is 18 months.

An assessor coach will be allocated to you and will visit your workplace on a regular basis, liaising with your work-based mentor, but you will also receive masterclass workshops from college tutors.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- Level 3 Early years Educator Apprenticeship Standard
- Paediatric First Aid Award
- Level 2 Functional Skills Maths (if required)

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

To secure a place of study on the Level 3 Early Years Educator programme, the minimum entry requirements are as follows:

- A full and relevant Level 2 qualification or significant industry experience; English and maths GCSE Grade 4/ Level 2 Functional Skills.
- Candidates may be accepted if all other requirements are met and they are working at Level 2 in maths, subject to initial assessment.
