This October, we're running workshops for **all staff and managers across the Partnership** to explore the upcoming **Social Care Reforms** due to be in place by 2027.

The sessions will:

- Explain the background to the reforms and the *Care Review*
- Share learning from the 10 Pathfinder Local Authorities
- Explore the Government's vision: *Stable Homes, Built on Love*
- Focus on key strands like **Family Led Decision Making**, **Family Help**, and **Multi-Agency Child Protection Teams**



We'll also look at how the reforms link to the **Children's Social Care National Framework**, with outcomes focused on: keeping families together, strengthening support networks, keeping children safe, and ensuring stable, loving homes.

These workshops are your chance to **learn, share your views, and be part of shaping the future of services in Solihull**.



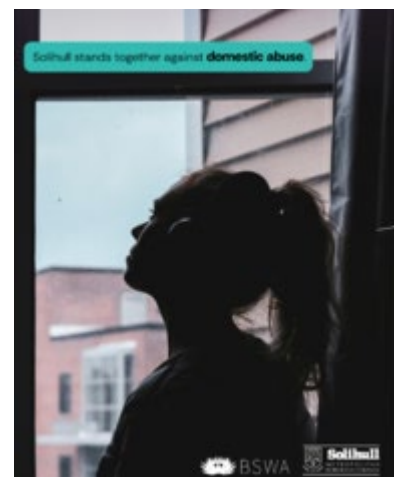
New domestic abuse awareness campaign - Partner Pack.
