staff in the hubs can put you in touch with different services in the area.

There are four Family Hubs in Solihull:

- Elmwood- Burton's Way, Smiths Wood – Now Open
- Riverside- Bosworth Drive, Chelmsley Wood – Now Open
- Evergreen- Kingshurst – Open
- Hatchford Brook- Elmdon

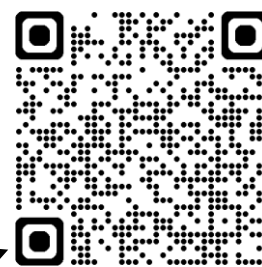
