

My Important Place Week beginning: July 11th

Enquiry based questions for the week n Hinduism:

What does it mean to worship in Hinduism?

What does it mean to show devotion?

What are sacred places for Hindus?

What does *dharma* (*duty*) mean to many Hindus?

Is it really possible to be reborn?

Learning outcomes:

Key stage 1

Pupils to know and understand the importance of the places of worship within Hinduism

To experience and reflect on what it is like to worship in Hinduism

To know and understand some of the symbols and main beliefs in the Hindu faith

To respond sensitively to the beliefs and practices of others

Key Stage 2

To reflect on important places to them and why they are important

To evaluate the concept of rebirth and reincarnation (year 5 and 6)

Looking at sacred places that are important to Hindus:

- The temple Mandir
- The shrine in the home
- Places of pilgrimage Varanasi and Vrindaban
