Assessments Without Levels

This seminar is aimed at governors from Primary Governors, particularly Link Governors dealing with curriculum and standards. The briefing will advise governors on the statutory assessment process for key stages 1 and 2. It will explain the reasoning behind the removal of levels and how they will be replaced. It will also discuss the implications this removal has on teaching and learning.

The intended learning outcomes are that governors will:

- Have an up-to-date understanding of how pupils' learning will be assessed at the end of key stages 1 and 2;
- Be familiar with the reasoning behind assessment without levels;
- Be aware of a number of approaches that schools may adopt to assess pupils' learning between statutory assessment points.
