1. The Life Ready Programme – Gareth Davies, Lode Heath School

Life Ready is a simple framework, designed to support schools and other organisations to develop independent, life ready young adults. It provides young people with the guidance and opportunities to progress and record their employability skills.

2. Achieving a quality award – Wendy Fitzmaurice, Hazel Oak School

There are already over 1100 schools, colleges and work based learning providers in England who either hold or are working towards a careers education, information, advice and guidance quality award. The Government recommends that all schools should work towards one of the nine quality awards validated by Careers England as an effective means of carrying out a self-review and evaluation of the school's programme.

3. Completing a careers audit – Lin Hatton, Birmingham Careers Service

Completing a careers audit can support an organisation to consider the effectiveness of their provision and where the gaps are.

Delegates will be allocated to one of three groups and the facilitators will circulate. Each discussion will last about forty minutes.
