Celebrate Diwali

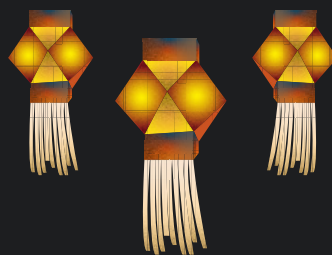
