Resubmit when the child is the correct EEF age/ EEF eligible		Sometimes people submit a 2 y/o child for level 1 or when children are not yet 2 y/o for L2. So, this is rejected with a request to reapply when the child is the correct age.		
There was insufficient evidence		We need REVIEWED plans to show the graduated approach >APDR, so if this evidence is not submitted [1 reviewed plan at L1 and 2 reviewed plans at 2] then the application will be rejected. We also need confirmation of the level of need from a LA SEND practitioner.		

This approach will be reviewed throughout 2024/2025.
