This termly meeting is for all early years leads for autism to:

- meet and share good practice
- receive updates and training relating to developing Good Autism Practice (GAP) across your setting
- enhance practitioners' knowledge and understanding of GAP
- help practitioners to question, evaluate and develop autism practice within their setting

The **Spring** meeting will focus on the **AET EY Transition Module 9–12**: exploring tools for planning for key transitions - such as transition into primary school.

Aims

This module will support you to:

- develop delegates understanding of the differences between macro and micro transitions
- increase delegates knowledge of why transitions can be challenging for autistic children
- support delegates to identify the key principles of transition support in the early years
- identify key considerations when planning early years transition support

Outcomes

After completing this module, you will be able to:

- understand the importance of a child-centred approach
- use a strengths and interests-based approach when planning for transitions
- develop their confidence in planning for everyday transitions
