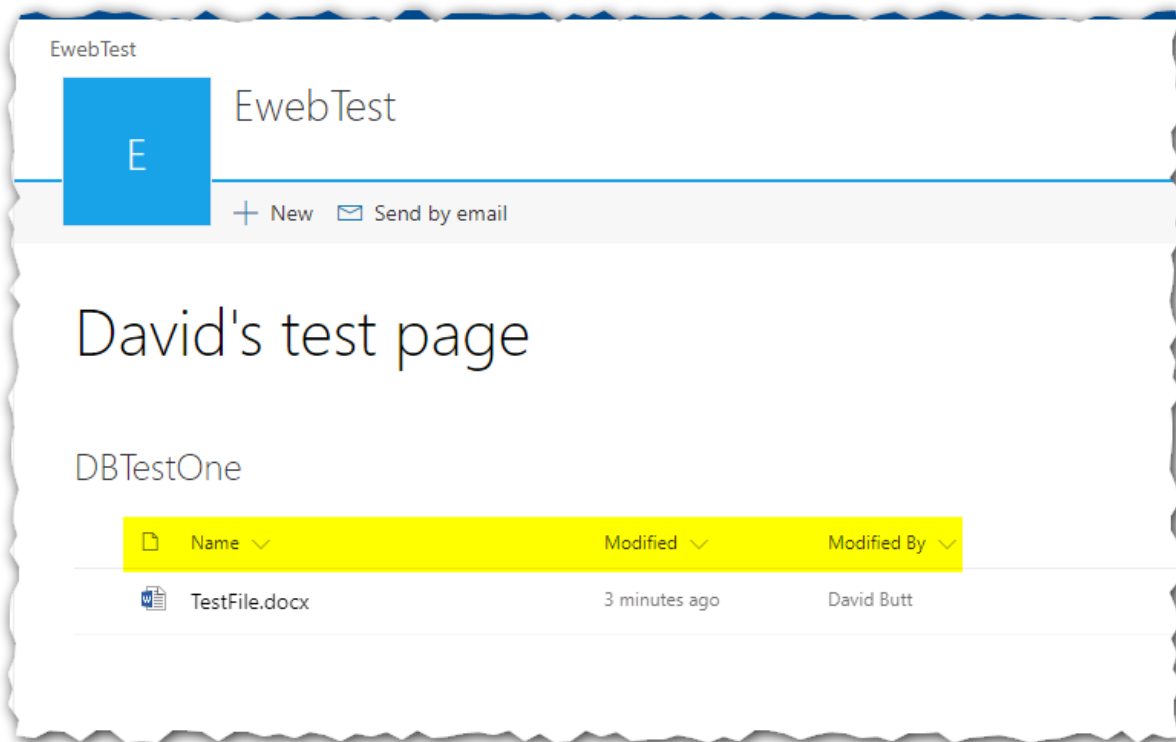


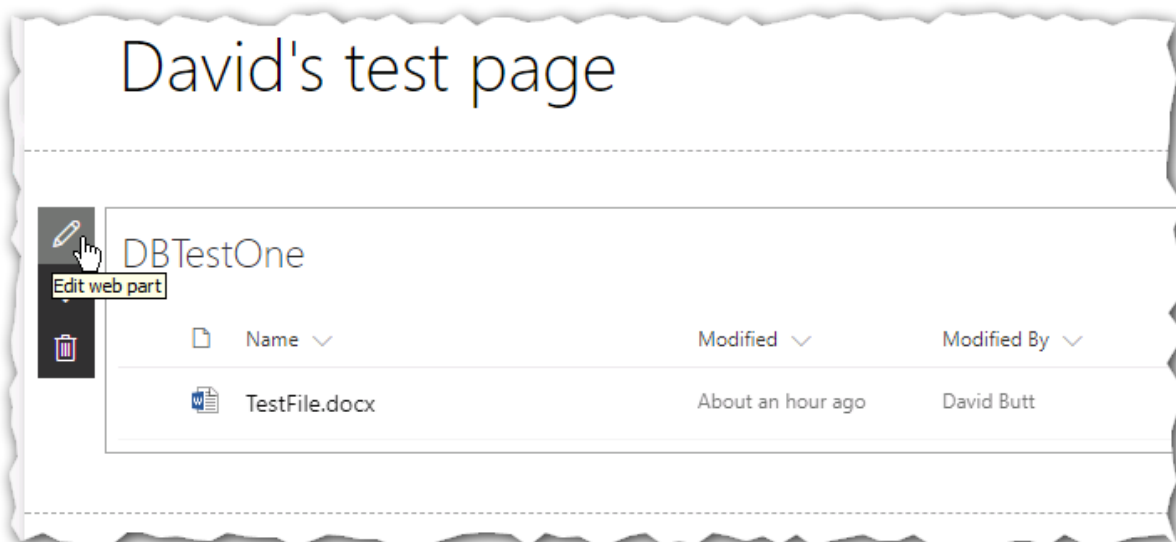




It has a test document library (DBTestOne) showing on it with the default view showing.

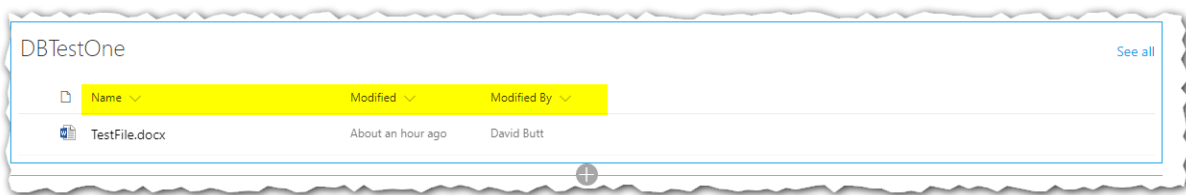

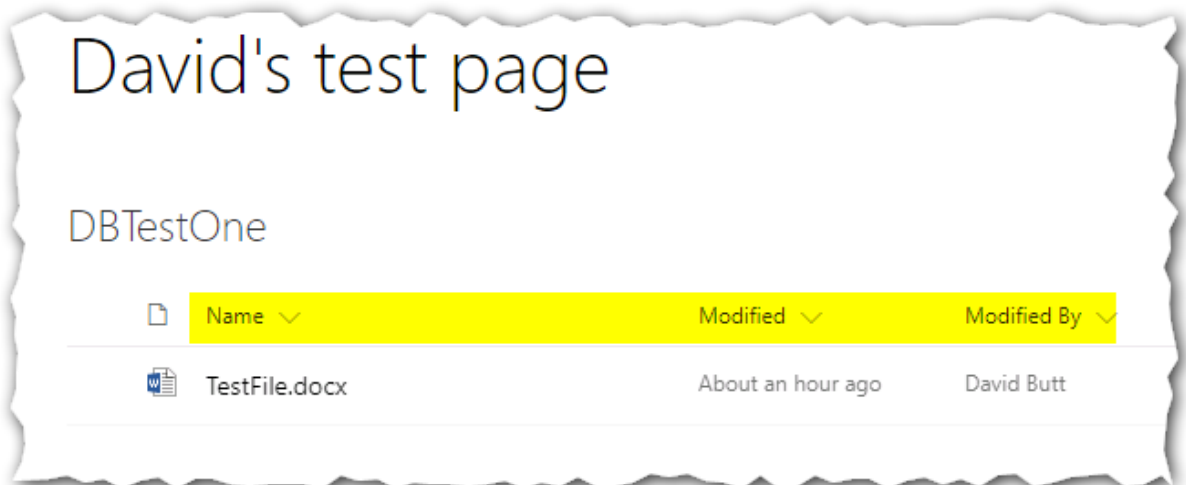

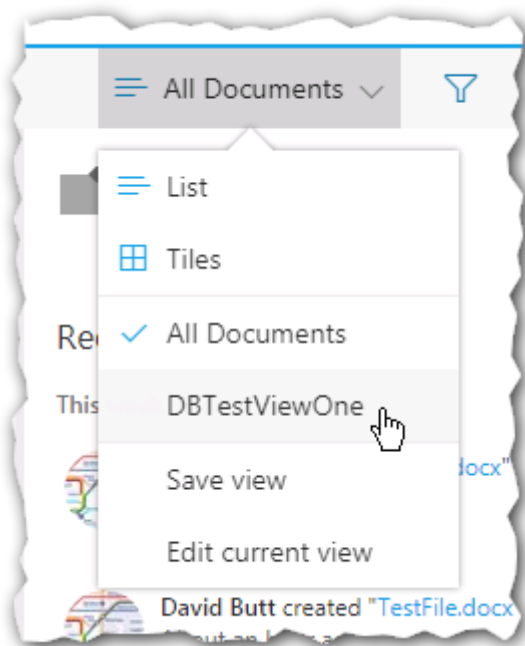
Web part still shows default view
