- South Warwickshire Foundation Trust were awarded the contract to provide the 0-19 service for Solihull in September.
- This includes: FNP, Health Visiting, School nursing and Infant feeding
- Named nurses and contact numbers have remained the same.

- Early identification of need – Targeted work: Improve outcomes
- 08:00 – 18:00 service

# Planned changes

- Health Assessment:
  - Reception: ASQ and NCMP
  - Year 6 and 9 HAPI -online tool (Lancaster model).
- Assessment Tools:
  - A Childhood Depression Assessment tool
  - The Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire.

# Planned changes

- Implement CHAT health (year 7 – 11) – online message management system
- Launch - healthforkids and healthforteens website: provide advice and support on a range of health issues including emotional and mental health
- Offer fortnightly drop in sessions in all senior schools and half termly drop in for year 6 and primary school parents

# Planned changes

- Appropriate referral to other services: CAMHs, Gps, Engage and Paediatricians.
- HCP
- Offer tier one advice and support on a range of health issues including; enuresis, emotional health and wellbeing and self harm.
- Provide 'core offer' information to all schools by March 2018
