

Birmingham PlayCare Network's (BPCN) Network house and operate The Scrapstore Birmingham. BPCN collects and sorts materials, or 'scrap', donated by individuals & businesses for redistribution to individuals and organisations supporting play and creativity.

BPCN scrapstore supports the reuse of unwanted materials that have been donated by businesses and individuals across Birmingham. We collect and sort waste/surplus materials which would often be diverted to landfill and redistribute it to out of school providers, schools, community groups and individuals.

The scrapstore offers out of school providers, schools, community groups and individuals the opportunity to access a wide range of high quality materials, save money and promote the reuse of waste materials.

The Lets Play programme actively encourages children to take risks to explore limits, venture into new experiences and develop their capacities, from a young age and from the earliest play experiences. It helps children take their classroom learning experiences into imaginative play outdoors.
